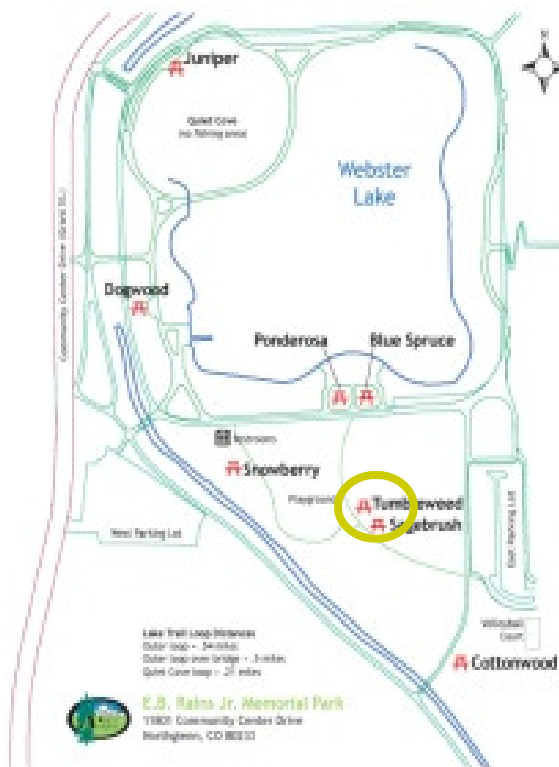

Proposed Koinonia Bylaws Changes

Several changes have been proposed to the Colorado Koinonia Bylaws. These changes were approved by the Colorado Koinonia Continuance Board at their April meeting and have been recommended for approval by the Koinonia Kommunity at the June Picnic Ultreya. According to the Bylaws, any amendments must be approved by a two-thirds majority of the Board and a majority vote of the Koinonia membership at a regularly scheduled Ultreya. The specific changes include the following:

1. Clarification that the Board as a whole may act as a nominating committee for any open positions.
2. Adding some flexibility to the list of Board positions. There will still be 12 board positions which must include a Chairperson, Treasurer, and Secretary, but the titles of the other Board positions may be modified based on the current needs of the organization and the gifts and abilities of those on the Board. Some positions may be able to be combined, allowing others to be split or new positions to be created.
3. Clarification that section IV.C.6.b. refers to Appointments to Specific Committees or Tasks, not Appointments to the Board. This section becomes section IV.C.7, which changes section numbers of a couple of other sections.
4. Allowing communications via the website and via e-mail instead of just via the Rooster Tale and mailings.
5. Clarification of the Conflict of Interest language in section IV.K.
6. Deletion of a rogue character “r” that was included in section VI.B.1.

Addition of posting requirements for Bylaws amendments to include both the Rooster Tale and the Koinonia website.

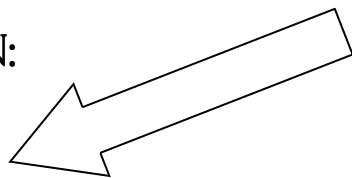
